You can register at any location; however, you will be assigned to play in one of the three groups listed.

#### **WHAT TO BRING:**

A parent/guardian and the PARTICIPANT must be present at registration. Please bring with you:

1. one copy of the player's birth certificate
2. one wallet size photo (face only, no hats)

In addition, a completed physical form must be provided by August 1 in order to begin practice. The form will be provided at registration. The completed form must be signed by a physician and dated in 2006 to be valid.

The Challenger Flag Football game is played with assistance of Palomar Pop Warner's 16 Associations volunteers as well as the Challenger Player's family members. Games are played on a shortened field for a limited amount of time. There will be no physical contact. Everyone has a chance to play. Practice will be held on Saturdays in the month of August and games will start in September and will be played each Saturday.
