This 14-week evidence-based social skills intervention provides the tools for building and maintaining positive friendships. Teens will learn how to:

- ◆ Use appropriate conversational skills
- ◆ Find common interests by trading information
- ◆ Appropriately use humor
- ◆ Handle rejection, teasing and bullying
- ◆ And MUCH more!

PEERS also includes a parent group equipping parents on how to:

- ◆ Assist their teens in making and keeping friends
- ◆ Expand their teen's social network
- ◆ Provide feedback through coaching
